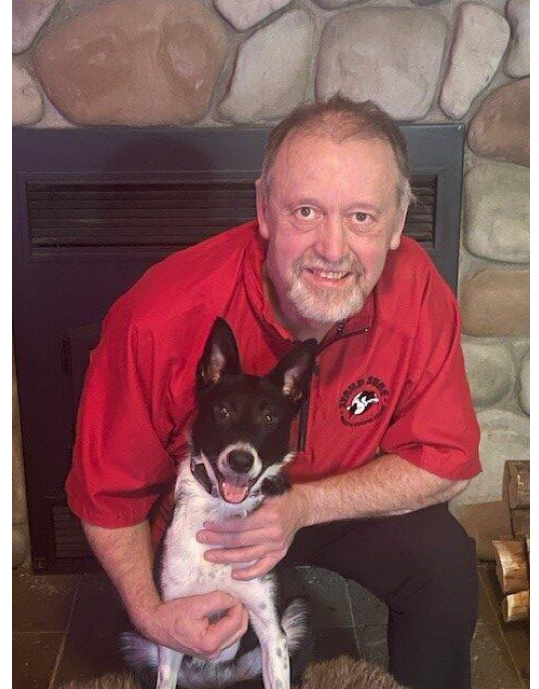


## **Darren Plumber**

# Reminders and Information

## **RIBBONS AND AWARDS**

Saturday's individual placements from the 4 runs that day will be handed out after events are complete approximately 6:30pm in the Award Presentation area. Ribbons from Saturday may be picked up on Sunday.

Individual placement ribbons for Sunday's events will be announced after the Steeplechase finals. Overall awards and ribbons for qualifying and placements will be announced following the individual placement ribbons on Sunday.

## **FOOD TRUCKS and EATS!**

We have some of the best food trucks in the Shuswap! **Tsilhqot'in BBQ** will be on site for breakfast and lunch/early dinner all 3 days. **The Lions Club of Sorrento** will also have pancake breakfast on Saturday and Sunday. **Kamui Japanese Curry food** truck will be on site for Saturday lunch and early dinner. Plus, there are lots of restaurants and grocery stores within a block or 2 of the event. AND...the government liquor store is a just over a block away from the fairgrounds.

## **SECURITY**

Volunteers will be monitoring crating areas and ring areas for competitor wrist bands. Please ensure you and your guests are wearing them and are visible. There will be security on-site overnight around the competition rings and designated crating area. However, we must stress - competitor's property on site is left at their own risk.

## **WRISTBANDS**

This will be a "closed event" to limit access to camping areas and non-competitor dogs on site. We will be including 2 wristbands (1 for competitor and 1 for companion) in each registration/check-in package. You will be wearing the same wristband for the entire weekend. If you have more than 1 travel companion, please ask for extra at check-in.

## Registration Information - Thursday May 30th

- Site prep begins at approximately 8:00am.
- Crating areas will be opened at approximately 11:00 am (as soon as we get markers up so there is no confusion!)
- RV spots are available after 10:00am.
- Registration will be available from 12:00pm – 6:00pm

All competitors entered in Regional and/or Steeplechase runs will need to show their AAC Dog ID/height card(s) at registration OR email copy to [trialsec@sadag.ca](mailto:trialsec@sadag.ca). The competitor also MUST make the height card(s) available for inspection at the start of the Regional event.

If a card is not complete (except for dogs under two with a temporary height card signed by Barb Brown) or you do not have your card(s), you must obtain a height measurement prior to competing. Times will be confirmed in the catalog released closer to the event.

- Thursday during early registration
- Friday measuring throughout the day as competitors arrive and as judges' schedules allow
- Saturday morning before regional event (if you are not arriving until then)

## RV Information

Please use the Camping/Vendor entrance off 5<sup>th</sup> Street SW (see map below).



We've done our best to accommodate everyone who asked to be camped next to or a near a friend, keeping in mind that the size, type and length of everyone's rigs impacts where we can place you. There will also be volunteers on site when you arrive, to help you find and get into your assigned spot.

If you are arriving on Thursday, May 30<sup>th</sup>, please arrive any time between **10:00am and 7:00pm**. If you will not be arriving until Friday and Saturday, we will have the RV entrance available at 7:00am.

There are also a few simple rules that we are asking everyone to follow for the comfort of all campers and out of respect for the fairgrounds that hosts many events in the community:

- This is dry camping only so please, absolutely no dumping of grey or black water tanks at the site.
- There is a nearby SaniDump at the Canadian Tire/Save On Foods parking lot a block away from the fairgrounds.
- No CAMPFIRES allowed; gas power fire-rings permitted
- No generators between 11pm and 6am please.
- Please pick up after your dogs in the camping area

## **Crating Areas**

**REMINDER!!!! Your crating area is 10 foot by 10 foot so do not expect to set up a shade tent larger that your space allows!!!**

All crating spots have been assigned and will be numbered, list to be posted on our website and on Facebook shortly. As a safety and security precaution, please leave the signs where you find them.

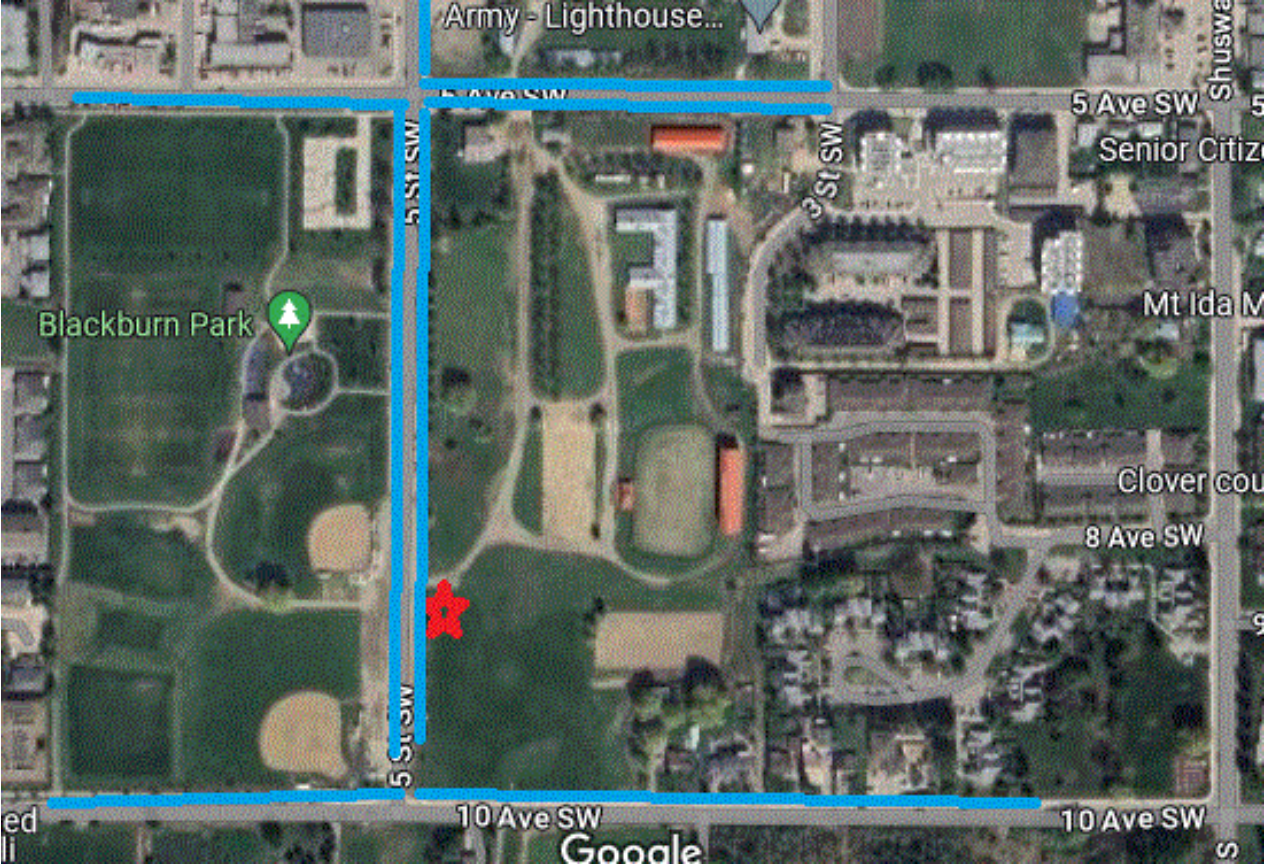
Crating area set up will be available anytime **11:00am until 8:00pm** on Thursday, May 30<sup>th</sup>. Please note that we will accommodate crate setup on Friday but will be limited vehicles on site as we will have events running.

**We will be allowing vehicles to enter the fairgrounds. THIS IS FOR DROP-OFF ONLY!!! You will be limited to 5 mins in the fairground! There will be Traffic Control volunteers directing the flow of traffic. Please be respectful!**

**There are over 120 premium crating spots so please be considerate with your time in the fairgrounds.** You will be close to the rings to unload your vehicle, take your items to your assigned crating area and then exit the fairgrounds to street park.

Barn crating will be able to drive up to the large barn to unload, take your items inside and then exit the fairgrounds to street park.

Volunteers will be reminding everyone to drop and go to park. You can return by foot after you park to complete your setup. See maps below for street parking (blue lines) and drop-off entrance (red star). This is for both premium and barn crating.



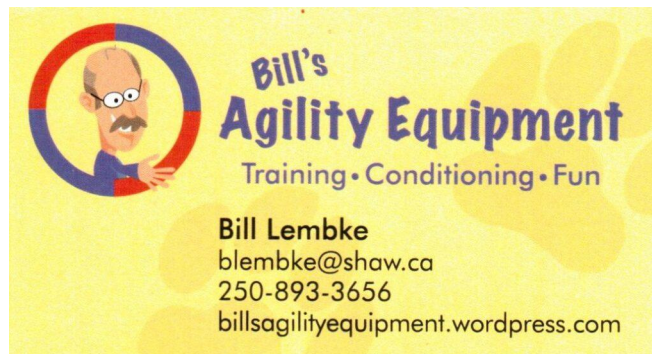

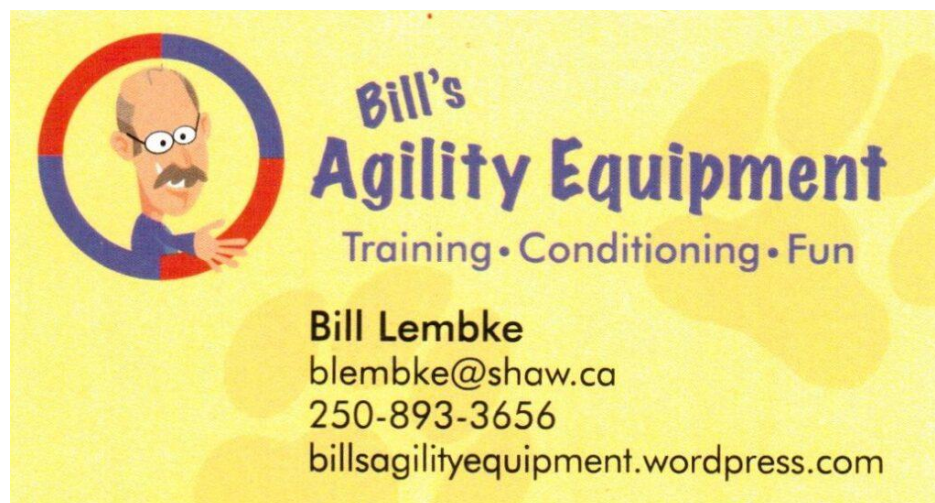

# FRIDAY WARM-UP RINGS

- Warm up rounds will start at 8 am and run until 4 pm.
- There are no jumps in the warmup rounds, so no jump height gate list will be created.
- Check in with the Gate on duty and have your name added to the running order.
- Ring #1 will have a standard height A- Frame (Sponsored by Creekside Animal Clinic)
- Ring 4 will have a lower height A-Frame
- You can use your tickets in one ring or both, if you have purchased more than one round, but the a-frame will not change heights at any time.
- Both courses will be the same. You have 70 seconds to run the course or practice.
- Purchased tickets will be in your registration bag. It is your choice when to show up for your run but please do not wait until the very end of the day – the rings will close at 4:30 pm. **(no refunds for unused tickets!)**

Food and toys will be allowed during the warmup runs on **FRIDAY only**, and under the following conditions:

- Toys be in good state of repair
- Toys do not contain audible noise makers
- Training aids (eg, clickers, target plates, mats, stride bars) are not allowed
- Food may not be thrown on the ground, or to the dog, and may only be fed from the hand or container – **nothing crumbly!**

# Sunday Steeplechase

On Sunday, after all regional events are complete, the 2024 Regionals Committee will host a Steeplechase Run-Off (non-sanctioned) based on the results from the two steeplechase events on Friday.

To qualify for the money round on Sunday, you need to finish in the top 2 of your class of either of Friday's courses, whether you qualified for AAC purposes or not.

If you finish in the top 2 in both Friday's runs, you still only get one chance to run on Sunday, we will take the next fastest dog by YPS if someone has been in the top 2 in both Steeplechase. This gives more people a chance at the Steeplechase run off.

There are potentially 4 competition spots in each of the 19 jump/division heights. Each height and division will have their own cash jackpot based on the number of entries in the two Friday Steeplechase events.

There will be no combining of heights or divisions. There is no fee to enter the run-off round (but it is only open to those who are invited to run based on Friday's results). Qualifiers list for the Sunday event will be posted Sunday morning in the results area along with the jackpot amounts for each run-off.

The net proceeds from the Friday Steeplechase events to the Jackpots.
